Manages your password linked to your ULBID</p> <p>How to log in? <p>Wireless networks VUBnext, Eduroam and VUBguest</p> <p>What? VUBnext: wireless network for students/staff Eduroam (education roaming) allows non-VUB users to log into wireless networks using the username and password they use in their home institutions. VUBguest: network for guests</p> <p>How to log in? VUBnext: use your NetID and password Eduroam: If you are a VUB student: log in with <code>firstname.lastname@vub.be</code> and NetID password; If you are a non-VUB student: use your Eduroam identity and password as defined by your home institution. VUBguest: contact Service Now https://vub.service-now.com/sp/ to request access.</p>	<p>Wireless network Eduroam</p> <p>What? Eduroam (education roaming) allows students, researchers and staff from participating institutions to obtain internet connectivity across campus and when visiting other participating institutions.</p> <p>How to log in with your pc? If you're a student: username is your ULBID followed by <code>@ulb.ac.be</code> (e.g. <code>tdupont@ulb.ac.be</code>) and password is the password linked to ULBID. Follow these instructions to connect: https://support.ulb.be/fr/-/quels-sont-les-codes-d-acces-au-wifi-/4.9 If you're a guest: follow https://www.guestroam.be/ and fill out the form, including your contact at ULB (person you are visiting). Select ULB and then ResULB or the faculty you are visiting. The wifi code will be sent straight to your laptop after validation of your mail/phone number and approval.</p> <p>How to log in with your smartphone/tablet or Macbook?</p>

Gives you access to your official ULB email and Office software like Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneDrive, Outlook and Teams.</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://www.office.com and log in with your ULB email address (firstname.lastname@ulb.be) and Microsoft 365 password (defined in MS 365 or sent to you by email).</p> <p>Forgot your O365 password? A communication and collaboration platform that combines chat capabilities, video conferencing, file storage, and integration with many other Microsoft 365 apps.</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://teams.microsoft.com and log in with your VUB email address (firstname.lastname@vub.be) and password. Alternatively, go through the Office 365 link https://www.office.com and select the Teams icon in the Applications bar on the left.</p>	<p>Teams</p> <p>What? <p>Cali - Student SelfService</p> <p>What? administration tool where you can manage and supervise your personal administration:</p>	<p>MonULB</p> <p>What? administration tool As a candidate, you can submit and follow up on your application (My application) and register for</p>

<p>Manage your personal information (address, phone, email, etc.); Check the status of your payments; Register or cancel courses; Re-enrol for your programme; Apply for another VUB programme; View your grades and download an official transcript of records</p> <p>How to log in? go to https://cali.vub.be and log in with your VUB email address (firstname.lastname@vub.be) and password. If this does not work, try to log in with your VUB NetID and password.</p>	<p>admission to exams (My registrations to exams). Once your registration has been validated, MonULB becomes a custom home page where you can supervise your administration, follow live announcements by your Faculty and ULB, check your university emails, receive your exam grades and deliberation results, download your student card and certificates etc.</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://monulb.ulb.be and use your ULBID and password</p>
<p>Canvas</p> <p>What? The digital learning platform where professors publish announcements and study material and you can communicate with fellow students and professors. Note: your courses appear in Canvas, but official course registration must be done through Cali.</p> <p>How to log in? Go to canvas.vub.be and log in with your VUB email address (firstname.lastname@vub.be) and password.</p>	<p>UV - Université Virtuelle</p> <p>What? The official virtual campus and learning platform of ULB. Gives you access to all course material and other documents and info posted by professors and assistants.</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://uv.ulb.ac.be/login and fill in your ULBID and password</p>
<p>Pointcarré</p> <p>What? Tool used by both students and staff to book a timeslot for oral exams.</p> <p>How to log in? Go to Canvas and select your course. Under 'Announcements' you'll see a link to the appointments list. Click on the link and login with firstname.lastname@vub.be</p>	
<p>Timetables and exam schedules</p> <p>What? Allows you to check the timetables for student groups or for courses, and the exam schedules per faculty.</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://student.vub.be/en/timetables-and-exam-schedules#timetable to check the timetables, and to https://student.vub.be/en/timetables-and-exam-schedules#exam-schedule to check the</p>	<p>Horaires ULB (new link as from 1/9/2021)</p> <p>What? The entry point for the courses and examinations timetables.</p> <p>How to log in? Go to http://ulb.be/horaires and select the category that meets your situation to access your schedules.</p>

Enables you to keep a clear overview of your courses (elective and compulsory), deadlines for assignments and tests (imported from Canvas) AND your personal agenda.</p> <p>How? Go to https://student.vub.be/sites/vub/files/icalendar_manual_en.pdf and follow the instructions to import your timetable into the O365 calendar.</p>	
<p>Library tools</p> <p>Affluence</p> <p>What? Library app which displays the libraries' location, opening hours, as well as their occupancy rate. You can book yourself a seat (compulsory in covid times).</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://affluences.com/centrale-Bibliotheek-VUB or https://affluences.com/medische-bibliotheek-vub and book a slot, using your VUB email address <code>firstname.lastname@vub.be</code></p> <p>EZProxy</p> <p>What? Library interface; allows you to consult electronic resources when you're off campus</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://biblio.vub.ac.be, search for the resource you want to consult, check in V link at the right if an electronic version exists; if it does, you get to the EZProxy screen where (as from 15/09/21) you log in with your VUB email address <code>firstname.lastname@vub.be</code></p> <p>VUBIS</p> <p>What ? Central search engine for all VUB libraries</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://biblio.vub.ac.be/iguana/www.main.cls?url=vub&language=eng.</p> <p>Click 'log in' and enter your VUB student card barcode number (10 digits) or library card barcode number (first 7 digits). Enter your 6 digit password (initially your birthday: DDMMYY).</p>	<p>Library tools</p> <p>Affluence</p> <p>What? Library app which displays the libraries' location, opening hours, as well as their occupancy rate. You can book yourself a seat (compulsory in covid times).</p> <p>How to log in? Library interface; allows you to consult electronic resources when you're off campus</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://bib.ulb.be/fr/services/ezproxy and use your ULBID and password</p> <p>Cible+</p> <p>What? Central search engine for all ULB libraries</p> <p>How to log in? Go to https://cibleplus.ulb.ac.be; in the right upper corner, select S'identifier and log in with your ULBID and password. Once you start looking for electronic resources, you are automatically logged in to EZProxy.</p> <p>DI.fusion</p> <p>What? Tool to encode your master thesis. This is required by some ULB faculties.</p>
